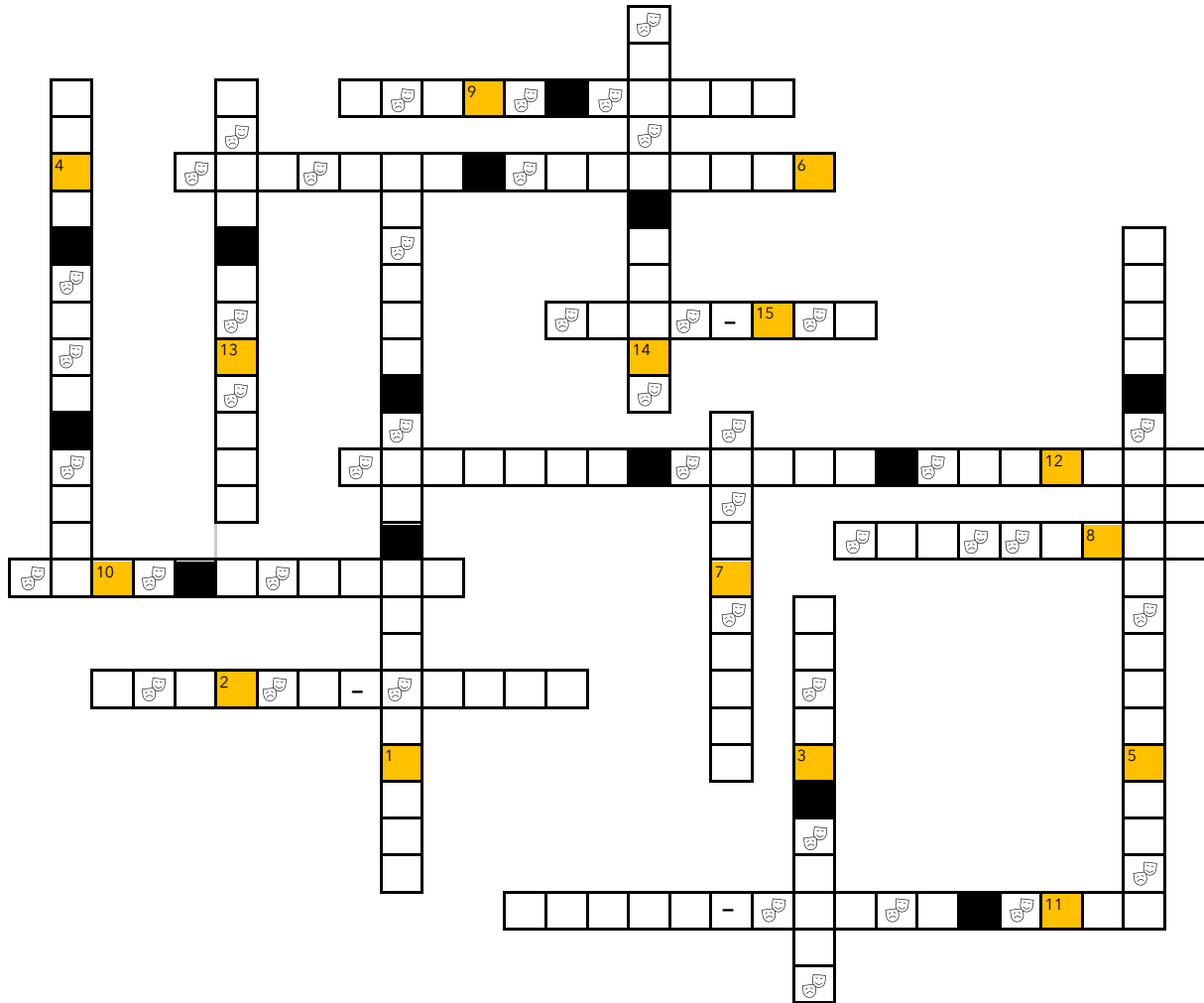


Summer Stock
